YOUR RESPONSIBILITY CODE

1. Always stay in control. You must be able to stop or avoid people or objects.
2. People ahead or downhill of you have the right-of-way. You must avoid them.
3. Stop only where you are visible from above and do not restrict traffic.
4. Look uphill and avoid others before starting downhill or entering a trail.
5. You must prevent runaway equipment.
6. Read and obey all signs, warnings, and hazard markings.
7. Keep off closed trails and out of closed areas.
8. You must know how and be able to load, ride and unload lifts safely. If you need assistance, ask the lift attendant.
9. Do not use lifts or terrain when impaired by alcohol or drugs.
10. If you are involved in a collision or incident, share your contact information with each other and a ski area employee.

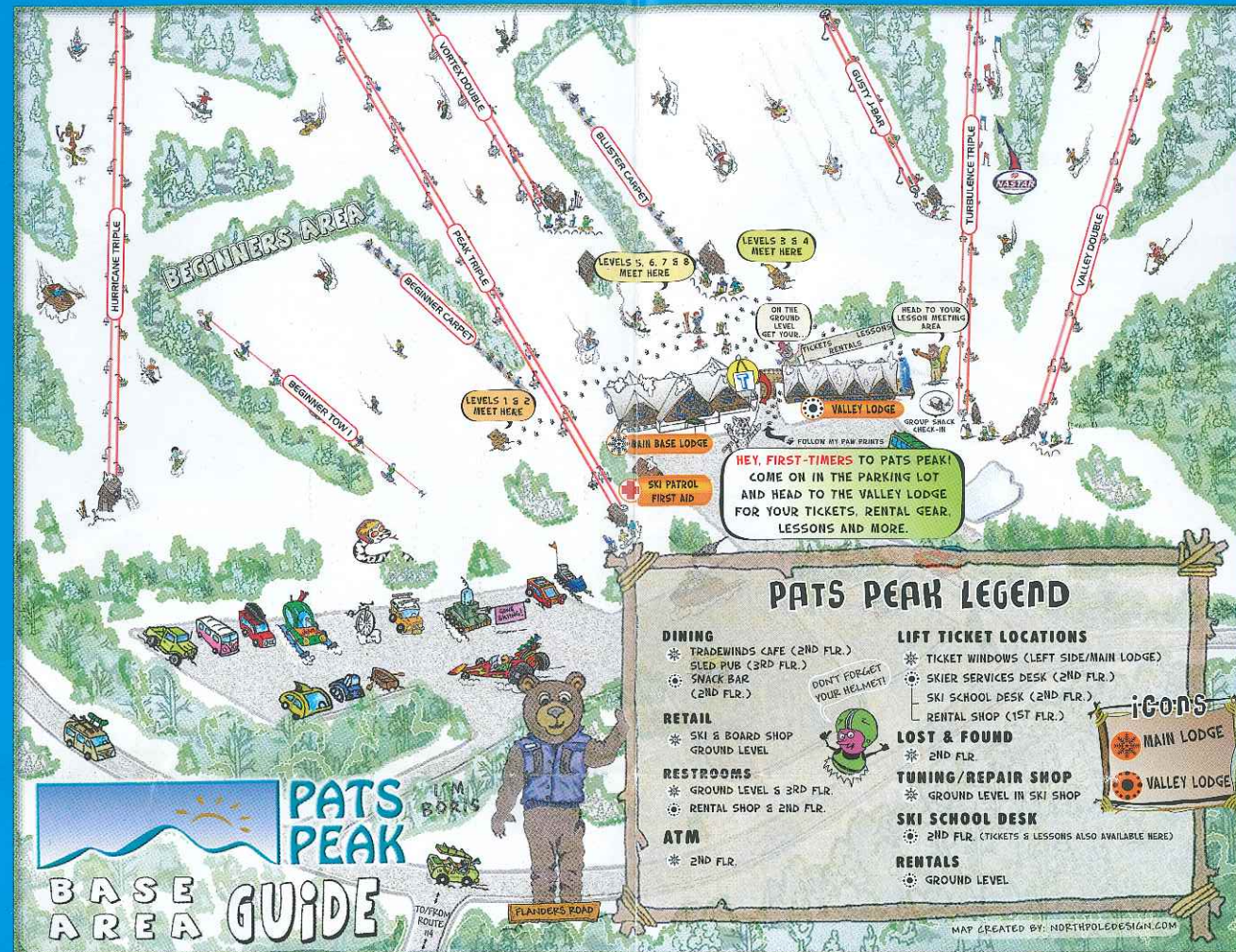

Must be 44" tall and at least 5 years old to snowtube. Ski boots are not allowed. You must lay down on your stomach on the tube.

Turbulence Terrain Park features include tabletops, rails, boxes and more. Microburst Progression Park is a park for kids and beginners, features include smaller boxes, rails, rollers & jumps.
